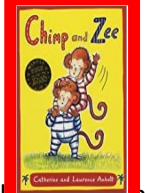
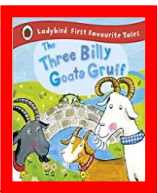


Year - Reception

English:



In Literacy the children will learn to hear and identify the sounds in words and noise. They will then move onto Phase 2 where they will learn to read the sounds SATPINMD and start to blend 2+3 sound words, They will practise identifying their own name and trying to write it without help.

Geography:

Using the books - Chimp and Zee and The Billy Goats Gruff we will be Learning about Rivers and mountains. The children will be looking at a globe and what it shows and understand how a globe can be used to find different countries.
