Reading

DISCOVER: History (Curriculum focus)

Transport Through the Ages:

Examine different forms of transport. Understand how transport has changed over time, and begin to develop a chronology of automobiles, trains, and space travel. Explore the history of space travel and significant events.

Mathematics:



This term we will be focussing on place value. We will learn to count one more and one less, order and compare numbers, introduce the concept of parts and whole numbers, tens and ones, and ordinal numbers (1st, 2nd, 3rd...).

Children will be given the opportunity to use concrete objects and manipulatives to help them understand the new concepts. Alongside this, children will use pictorial representations to help them reason and solve problems.

Physical Education:

This term we will be concentrating on improving our multi-skills. We will be learning to travel in different directions and different ways. We will explore static balances, using different parts of the body.

Science: This term we will be learning about everyday materials. We will learn to distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made.

Identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock. Describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials. Compare and group together a variety of everyday materials based on their simple physical properties.
