

English (Reading and writing):

Text drivers/books to share:

- How the Wright Brothers Conquered the Skies
- 'FArTher' - Grahame Baker-Smith

Reading: This term, we are beginning to look at poetry and rhymes with our stories and books.

Writing: We are focussing on writing skills such as alliteration, patterns and rhymes. We will be writing our own poems at the end of the unit.

Discover: History (Curriculum Focus)

The First Aeroplane Flight:

The class will learn about the Wright brothers and the story of their historic first aeroplane flight on December 17th 1903. We will find out about the history of flight and begin to understand how aeroplanes fly.

Mathematics:

This term we will continue to begin to develop their skills with multiplication and division. Children will be given the opportunity to use concrete objects and manipulatives to help them understand the new concepts. Alongside this, children will use pictorial representations to help them reason and solve problems. We are also going to approach fractions in a practical and visual way to secure the children's baseline knowledge of them.

Physical Education (Invasion games):

In PE, the class will learn skills to participate in simple invasion games. Children will learn different ways of travelling and will apply these as they move on to travelling with a ball.

Religious Education:

In RE this term, we will be looking at Jesus' life and the people he met. We will also be looking at the important Jewish festival, Passover.

Modern Foreign Languages:

For French, we will be learning the names of 11 colours as well as introducing some animals.

STEAM:

Science: This half term, we will be developing our knowledge of plants. The class will be taught to identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees. Additionally learning how to identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.

Computing: This term the children will develop their understanding of the various aspects of using a computer to create and manipulate text. They will become more familiar with using a keyboard and mouse to enter and remove text. Finally, the class will consider the differences between using a computer to create text and writing text on paper.



CREATE: (Curriculum Support)

Music: We will continue to follow our music programme on charanga and learn about the rhythm and beat of the music. The class will be introduced to tempo and dynamics with a focus on how music makes the world a better place.

Art: In art, we will be focussing on our drawing skills. The class will aim to be proficient in their drawing technique and can use these skills to develop and share their ideas, experience, and imagination.

PSHE:

We will continue to follow our PSHE programme on SCARF. This term we will be looking at valuing difference with Mrs Young.

Explore: Geography (Curriculum Support)

This term, we will be exploring the similarities and differences in relation to places, objects, materials and living things.

We will be discussing the features of our own immediate environment and how environments might vary from one another across the world.
