<p>English: In English we will be exploring books about bears, including Going on a bear hunt, Goldilocks and the Three bears and Whatever next? We will use these stories as a starting point to create our own writing.</p>	<p>Maths: We will be exploring number and place value, looking at the value of each integer. We will also be exploring addition and subtraction. These will be done through saying, showing, drawing and writing. We will also be exploring length.</p>	<p>Music: We will be learning to sing using our voices. We will also be experimenting with sounds a bear would make and how the different size bears would sound. We will also explore sounds for when we are happy, sad, scared, excited.</p>	<p>Science: Exploring mini-beasts in the environment, looking at their habitat and what their features are. We will be researching bears and looking at the different types of bears there are, linking to geography and where they come from. We will also be exploring Autumn.</p>
<p>Phonics: We will be continuing with our learning of phonics through letters and sounds. We will be learning alternative versions of different sounds and about reading and spelling irregular words.</p>		<p>PE: We will continue with our physical development through building on the fundamentals of movement.</p>	<p>RE: We will be looking at harvest and saying thank you.</p>
<p>Art and Design: We will be exploring how to create pictures of bears and looking at using textures to create the pictures.</p>	<p>Computing: We will be using sound effects to the various animals in our version of 'We're going on a bear hunt', showing that we understand what algorithms are and how they are implemented as programs.</p>	<p>Geography: We will be exploring where we are - our classroom, our school and its grounds - looking for the different features. We will be exploring the different features through hunting for bears. We will also be looking at where in the world bears live.</p>	<p>Design Technology: We will be designing, making and evaluating a party bag for a Teddy Bear's picnic. We will also be designing our own bear cave, using different tools to create the desired outcome.</p>
