# English:





In English, we are learning how to write a set of instructions so that they can be sent to Mrs Grinling and help her with her dilemma. We will also be learning how to write a diary entry in both topics we will look at the features and content needed to produce a good example.

### **EXPLORE** (Curriculum Focus)

### Geography:

Year 1 and 2 will be focusing on "Our Island" and the United Kingdom. We will be learning about the four points on a compass and how this relates to maps. In addition, the children will be exploring the four countries that make up the United Kingdom, the five oceans of the world and the seven continents.

### Mathematics

Year 1 and 2 will be focusing on the following topics:

- Place Value
- The four operations  $(+ x \div)$
- Measurement: Length
- Fractions

### Physical Education:

The children will be learning how to develop their single and dual leg balance as well as the fundamentals of movement through multi-skill lessons (agility, balance and coordination).

# Religious Education:

Year 1 and 2 will be focusing on belonging in the Christian faith. They will focus on symbols of the Christian faith, baptism and explore how Christians demonstrate their beliefs.

### Science:
