

## Year 3/4

### English:

In English, we will be using a range of texts and information to continue to develop our use of language. We will be writing a persuasive letter to help save the orangutans. In Reading, we will focus on making simple inferences relating to characters' thoughts and feelings.



### Physical Education:

We will be focusing on ball control skills. In particular, how to dodge or catch balls thrown by the opposition whilst attempting to strike their opponents in the same way.

### Religious Education:

In RE, the children will be focusing on Christianity. They will learn about the word symbol, the different crosses, meanings, and their relevance to Christians.

## Spring 2

### Mathematics:

In Maths this half term, we will be focusing on number and place value and applying this knowledge through both reasoning and problem solving. The children will also work on securing their times table knowledge.

### **STEAM**

Science: In Science, we will be focusing on plants. Children will learn to identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants, explore the requirements of plants for life and growth (air, light, water, nutrients from soil, and room to grow) and investigate the way in which water is transported within plants.

Computing: This term, children will develop their graphic and presentation skills. They will learn to draw with different shapes and lines, order and group objects and change the shape and size of shapes.

PSHE: This Spring term, we will continue to focus on the different ways we can keep ourselves healthy and safe. We will also take part in activities for Empathy week and look at ways of caring for the environment.
