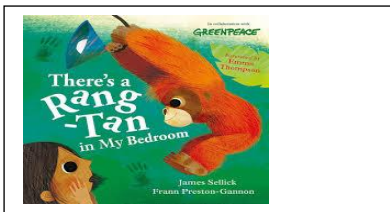


## Year 6
