


## Year 6

### Discover (Curriculum Focus)

#### Geography: Focus on the Olympics in Japan

- Locate Argentina and Japan, using maps to focus on Argentina and Japan, concentrating on their environmental regions, key physical and human characteristics, countries, and major cities
- Name and locate counties and cities of the United Kingdom, geographical regions and their identifying human and physical characteristics, key topographical features (including hills, mountains, coasts and rivers), and land-use patterns
