Dear Parents/Carers

Welcome from the extended schools team, if you would like your child/children to attend any clubs then please **phone the office before 8:30am or after 3pm** or **via email** (we respectfully ask you **not to** phone the main office between 9am & 3pm) and mark it for the attention of Mrs Mannix at l.mannix@stenburyfederation.co.uk to book your child's place.

Breakfast club runs from 8am-8:45am and Fun Zone runs from 3pm-5pm daily.

We currently serve juice, milk, toast and cereal at breakfast club, but would be open to suggestions for any alternatives. We will also provide access to board games, drawing, and an area to do homework, if needed, Lego and the Wii. There will also be an area for children to sit quietly and read if they so wish.

All clubs are £2.50, unless stated otherwise and run for one hour unless shown.

These are the clubs, indicated on the next page we are currently running, more will be added as the year progresses, especially with regard to sporting activities, and please remember we are always open to new ideas, contact Mrs Mannix via email, as to what you would like us to try and provide.

There will always be children's free choice and we will offer outside games providing the weather is not too hot or cold! Even if the child is booked into the clubs, if they want to participate in an alternative activity we will always support the child's choice.
