You are invited to attend a special online safety evening event hosted by **Hampshire Police and NSPCC** which aims to support parents and carers of children aged 7-11 years with keeping their children safe online

**Date:** Tuesday 25 June

**Time:** 6.30pm to 8pm (arrival from 6pm)

The evening will provide an insight to **local online safety initiatives from Hampshire Police** and their Megan's Story campaign, followed by an **NSPCC online safety workshop**.

The evening is a great opportunity to gain skills and knowledge to understand more about the internet and technology as children do – from online games and cyber bullying, through to setting up privacy settings and controls - and to help you have the right conversations with your children.

The event will cover the recently launched Megan's Story Campaign from Hampshire Police which aims to tackle the issue of children sending and sharing nude/sexual pictures online; followed by delivery of the reputable NSPCC online safety workshop for parents and carers by NSPCC staff.
